

Glocester Land Trust 2023-2024 Hunting Regulations

The Glocester Land Trust allows Deer and Turkey hunting for individuals that possess a valid 2023-2024 RI DEM hunting license. Hunters wishing to hunt on Glocester Land Trust (GLT) property must have a valid hunting license and receive written permission from the GLT. GLT permitting is limited to 50 hunters per species per year, on a first come, first served basis.

Muzzleloader deer hunting is allowed on the following GLT properties:

**Sprague Farm
Seldom Seen Farm**

Archery turkey and deer hunting is allowed on the following GLT properties:

**Garrity Woodland
Hopkins Woodland
Seldom Seen Farm
Sprague Farm**

*Hunters must follow the RI DEM 2023-2024 hunting and trapping and regulations (<https://dem.ri.gov/media/36651/download>).

Shotgun hunting is PROHIBITED on all Glocester Land Trust properties.).

Permit Application Process:

Option 1: Hunters are also able to apply electronically by visiting the GLT website (www.glocesterlandtrust.org) and filling out the 2023-2024 hunting application. Applications will be reviewed on a weekly basis, with applicants receiving GLT hunting permits via the email address provided. Permits will be issued on a first come, first serve basis until depleted.

Option 2: Hunters are able to apply in person by appointment by calling Roy Najecki at 401-647-3631. Permits are issued on a first come, first serve basis.
